Modernized User Experience

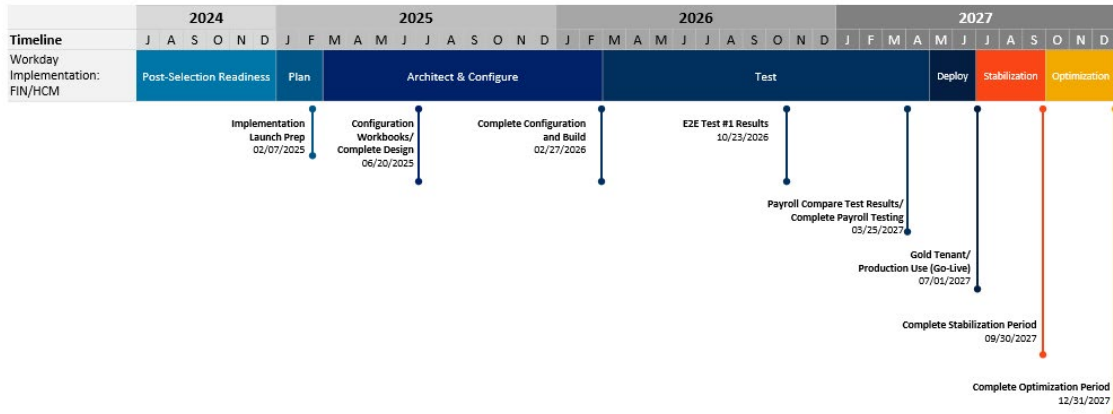
